Product Description:

DAP® DYNAGRIP® 3498 Sub-Floor Construction was developed to meet the demands of the professional installer. This adhesive will perform in the real world job site conditions, it can be applied to wet and frozen lumber and will extrude easily at temperatures as low as 20° F. DYNAGRIPTM 3498 when applied according to directions will reduce floor squeaks and improve the structural performance of the floor assembly.

Suggested Uses:

Adheres to most common building materials including; plywood, OSB, metal, drywall, masonry, treated lumber, FRP (fiberglass Reinforced panels)

Not recommended for: Most plastics, foamboard and continuous water submersion.

Surface Preparation & Application:

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Surfaces must be clean, structurally sound and free of foreign material.
- 2. Pre-cut and fit materials before applying adhesive.
- 3. Trim nozzle to desired bead size. 3/8" bead is recommended for subfloor applications.
- 4. Puncture inner foil seal.
- 5. Load cartridge into applicator gun.

- 6. Apply a continuous bead to joists, studs or backside of panels.
- 7. Within 10-15 minutes, position and press substrates firmly into place. If left open longer than 15 minutes, scrape off and reapply.
- 8. Install nails or screws within 10-15 minutes.
- 9. Allow to dry for 24 hours before exposing to heavy traffic.

APPLICATION TIPS: TONGUE & GROOVE SUBFLOOR: Use a 3/8" continuous bead on joists. Use ample bead of adhesive in all grooved channels (remove excess squeezed out adhesive before it dries). Panel joints should not be tight. Allow 1/8" gap for expansion. Position and nail or screw within 30 minutes. Proper installation methods for sub-floorings must be followed. DECKS: Use 1/4" adhesive bead on every joist for additional strength and to prevent squeaks. Nail planks at every other joist. Pre-drill nail holes.

For Best Results:

Apply in temperatures above 0 °F. Keep adhesive at or above 40 °F prior to use for easier gunning.
